

Discussion Questions on the Room For Doubt Video “Why Do You Still Believe, Grandpa?”

Watch the short video (6:30) and use these suggested questions to encourage reflection and promote discussion.

1. Do you have someone in your life (like Grandpa in the video) that you can talk to about your questions or doubts about Christianity? Who is that? Why do you think they are “safe” to talk to?
2. The video touches on the following topics: meaning, mortality, morality, matter, living matter, and the Messiah. What questions do you have about these topics? Discuss them.
3. What sticks out from the video as a highlight or two? What are your big “take-aways”?
4. If you believe in God, briefly describe the God you believe in. What are His characteristics?
5. If you believe in God, what are the three or four main reasons why?
6. “Christianity” means many different things to different people. How would you describe “Christianity”? What are the “core” ideas and practices of Christianity?
7. Do you think it’s possible to have an adequate foundation for morality *without God*? Explain why or why not.
8. How you see the relationship between science and the Christian faith? Did this video help you with this question? How?
9. The video stresses the importance of *comparing* the alternatives—comparing different religious and philosophical beliefs. Is that something that you think you have done or can do? Explain.
10. When compared to other philosophies and religions, what seems *unique* about Christianity?
